## **RECOMMENDATION**

The Executive Committee recommends approval of the proposed budget.

#### **BACKGROUND**

Planning's proposed budget for Fiscal Year 2025-2026 is provided for your review and approval.

Planning staff has developed a balanced budget, with revenues and expenditures each identified at \$8,313,250. Appropriations from the City of Knoxville and Knox County are an important source of revenue for the agency and represent 33 percent of the projected total.

# Highlights from the budget include:

- The City of Knoxville's appropriation is 19% of total revenues, and Knox County's is 14%.
- Fee revenue will account for approximately 8% of total projected revenue.
- Grant reimbursements comprise approximately 49% of the agency's revenue.
- Of the \$4,125,847 of grant revenue, \$3,365,233 is passed through to agencies that provide transportation services and consultant services.
