16 South Central St. - Old City Entertainment Venue

DESCRIPTION

The owner is proposing an exterior roof deck on the single story roof area for the purpose of outside events. These might include weddings, receptions, parties, or events with music and dancing. The deck itself will span between walls with steel bar joist and wood or composite construction to provide a level deck area above the existing roof area.

Access to the exterior roof deck will be from the existing second floor of the existing building. A new arched opening matching those on the lower level interior will open the second floor to an enclosed stair leading to the deck level. The roof deck level will be approximately 4 feet above the existing second floor

The roof entry / access stair will be a barreled roof enclosure of translucent glass or plastic glazing with the stairs paralleling the wall face and extending only 4 to 5 feet from that wall. The location proposed for this access stair enclosure is 30 or more feet back from the front wall such that direct vision of this new construction from the street level is not anticipated. Long views from the west side of the street looking south may catch the top of the barrel roof, if any at all.

The deck construction itself will not be visible from the street level at all. The edge of the roof deck parallels the front wall and is set back from there approximately 10 feet. Instead of a railing or guardrail, the deck will be bordered by a planting barrier. The barrier will be an iron or steel framework approximately 18 to 24 inches in height that will hold multiple 2 or 3 gallon plant pots. Plant pots can then be pulled and maintained or replaced entirely. Planting in this size posts will probably be no more than 18 inches in height.

Although people or light may be seen, we anticipate that no permanent construction will be visible from the sidewalk level and no changes are proposed to the building facades. Lighting has not been fully explored but will likely be deck mounted bollards, poles, or up lights. Existing brick



side walls may be illuminated at night from below. These brick side walls may require some repair or maintenance but no change in form or materials is anticipated for them.


Joist pockets in the existing north party wall indicate structure for two more levels which no longer exist. Toward the rear of the deck, we may utilize open wood beaming to support lights or decoration, but nothing has not been specifically designed or planned in that regard.


Since no changes are proposed for the front facades and since the new construction is observing the prescribed setback and since permanent construction will not be readily visible from the street, we request a Certificate of Appropriateness be give for the proposed roof deck.


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
