





## Submission for Certificate of Appropriateness January 21, 2019

This is a proposal to replace the existing canopy over the lower east entry off of Locust Walnut Street into the First Baptist Church. This is a small secondary entry into the facility and as was the case for most buildings of this era, originally it had no canopy at all.



The entry now serves as the outside entry into our young adult ministry known as "Dwell". Main access is of course through the interior of the church but this entry is utilized for weeknight bible studies and other special times during the week.

There are two reasons for the desire to replace this canopy. Firstly, the fabric cover is deteriorating, leaks and it is discolored which makes it rather unsightly on the side of our church building. Secondly, from an aesthetic standpoint, the size and design of the canopy are not appropriate for the era or for the details of the brickwork design. There could be some argument for the rounded shape given the arched brickwork over the openings; however, the canopy is considerably smaller than the arched brick soldier courses it covers. It looks like someone wearing a hat that is several sizes too small for their head.

A larger rounded canopy would look completely inappropriate for this historic structure. Instead, we propose to replace the existing canopy with one that is a simple, timeless design, flat, straight unit which will not disgrace the design of the façade and be quality construction with long life and virtually no maintenance. The material will be bronze anodized aluminum with powder-coated overhead supports. Size will be approximately 12 feet wide to cover the brick arch over the doorway and approximately 4 feet projection to provide weather protection for those entering or exiting Dwell. The unit will be fabricated and installed by Rusco Custom Canopies, Knoxville.
